by bicycle or on horseback. Due the length of the trail, it is recommended that the traveller complete it over two days. ted and its compact surface allows for it also to be travelled

### DAY 1

- **.** Ta. The trail begins at a rest area in Villanueva de la Serena close to the corner of Paseo del Castelar and Calle de San Benito, beside the railway line. It passes under Ronda de la Hispanidad and continues on, crossing the EX-A2-R2 road and a nearby canal.
- Between private estates it runs as far as the River Guadiana, crossing over a viaduct at the start of which there is an section. information panel on the most notable features of this
- The route continues parallel to an asphalt road that leads to the siphon of the Orellana Canal, where it diverts and crosses the N-430 over a pedestrian bridge, arriving at Santa Rena station.
- rd. The trail then crosses a bridge over the River Gargáligas and, at El Torviscal, it passes under a three-arch bridge. This section of the route cuts across farm fields until, after crossing a canal and another three-arch bridge under the EX-351 and passing Campo Lugar station, it becomes a thick oak meadow, through which the trail advances parallel to the Ruecas River, until it crosses the Orellana Canal.
- The route continues along a bridge over the Ruecas



This trail, which was inaugurated in 2007, joins Villanueva de la Serena (Badajoz) and Logrosán (Cáceres), following an old railway line which had been planned to connect this area with Talavera de la Reina. Work was abandoned definitively with the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War. At 53.2km long, in addition to the beauty of the landscape, it offers

the traveller the opportunity to discover the large wintering area for cranes from Northern Europe; they arrive punctually every year for their stay on some of the peninsula's finest pastureland.

These routes take us to the countryside to discover the biodiversity and beauty of our precious natural heritage, and discover the villages, sights, traditions and people that are part of the unique cultural landscape of our country. le trails and traditional routes, for public use and enjoyment.

Since 1993 the Ministry for Agriculture and Fisheries, Food and the Environment's Nature Trails Program aims to restore former transport infrastructures such as railway tracks, catt-

area and from which, crossing another area of pasture land, once can access Madrigalejos by road. re the landscape turns agricultural once again. Before reaching Madrigalejos station, it crosses a pedestrian bridge over road EX-378, alongside which there is a rest River, close to the mouth of the Pizarroso stream, whe-

- **2a.** The trail continues behind a farm with a tower silo, before snaking between oak trees and grasslands where the area's plentiful avifauna. the frequent puddles serve as drinking troughs for the local livestock who peacefully share the pastures with
- 2b. The trail reaches the Hitos irrigation pond, built to ensure irrigation for the estate of the same name where one can spot a number of wetland birds. At this point, the pastureland once again gives way to farm fields followed by gorse and, finally, an open pasture that accompanies the visitor to the end of the trail.
- at Zorita-Lavadero station, from where once can catch a glimpse of the Ruecas River, which runs quite close to After crossing the Las Dehesas Canal, the trail arrives the Nature Trail at certain points.
- 2d. From here, the trail continues parallel to the river until it approaches Logrosán, where the trail ends at the old sta-tion after crossing an area of gorse and a section of soft meadows with scrubs


