Here, the Nature Trails running through Valencia and Murcia are briefly described: Among them, there are short routes such as Dénia, La Safor or Molins d'Aigua, as well as some longer one such as Turia - Cabriel, Noroeste or the last kilometres of Santander - Mediterráneo.

This nature trail runs along and old railway line built during the decade of the 1920s, for the purpose of transporting

Maigmó Greenway (Alicante).

L'Antic Trenet (Valencia).

This trail recovers part of the railway track from Carcaixent to Denia, considered to be one of the first railway lines in the Iberian Peninsula. It runs through the territory of Serra de la Murta and the valley of Valldigna, an area of great scenic and cultural value

Dénia Greenway (Alicante).

railway line. This narrow gauge line, unused since 1974, was at its origin pulled by animal force. In fact, horse stables where strategically placed along the road so horses may be changed. The La Safor Nature Trail runs along the layout of the old Carcaixent-Dénia railway, whose works started in 1864 and is thus considered the oldest narrow-gauge train in the Iberian peninsula; prior to that date, the route was covered to the contract of t by a tram pulled by animal force. Today, a 6.5 km section of that railway have become a bicycle track and a pedestrian path between the towns of Gandía and Oliva
